I represent the State of Colorado in the above-captioned litigation you commenced in the United States District Court. By now, you should have received my motion to dismiss all claims against the State. Because the motion raises the State's right to be free of the burdens of litigation in the federal courts under the Eleventh Amendment to the United States Constitution, I intend to follow it up with a motion to stay all discovery and disclosures. Before filing a motion to stay, I am required under Local Rule 7.1(A) to confer with you, to learn whether you will oppose such a motion, and to attempt to resolve differences we might have concerning the relief that will be requested in the motion to stay discovery and disclosures.
