Why Aren't Cures Readily Available?

IHealthTube: We've talked to a number of doctors here this weekend at the Health Freedom Expo, and they have similar stories that you have that we've been able to do this, and it's been simple because of this and this. What is holding solutions like that back from becoming mainstream therapy?

Joel Wallach: OK, well two reasons, Scott. Number one, there's insurance. People say, "why should I spend two bucks a day for a treatment that my doctor pooh-poohs when I can get the treatment that he wants me to do for free from insurance." You know, we want that "Canadian free health care." And so that mentality in the American public has held it back because the public is not demanding the cure, if you will, just from something simple but it might cost them a third of the cost of a cup of Starbuck's coffee.

The second thing is the pharmaceutical industry drives things. You see, there's no law requiring doctors to cure people when there's a cure available. There is no law requiring doctors to prevent diseases in people when prevention is known.

Now, if I were the U.S. Surgeon General, the first thing I would do is pass a law. You see this agency, they can make a law. They don't even need to go to Congress to get I approved, they can just make a law. Well, I would make a law by fiat. I would make a law that said if there is a disease that is curable with anything, whether it's an herb or a drug or a nutrient, if it's curable and the physician just treated the symptoms as opposed to curing it — if there's a cure available — I would put in jail for a class A felony for 25 years to life. And by the time you did it to the first thousand physicians, the rest of them would start recommending the cure. Right? Because they wouldn't want to go to jail.

But, of course, that's not going to happen ... with the pharmaceutical and medical lobbies too powerful, that's not going to happen. So what has to happen is education. For the last 33 years ... this is the thirty-third year I've been doing this, Scott, giving 300 free lectures a year, to educate people that they do have options.

Well it's only been in the last two years, with the financial meltdown, with the medical meltdown, that people have begun to say, "What is this stuff you've been talking about, Wallach?" Suddenly they're interested, because if you lose your job you don't have insurance. Suddenly now what they perceived of as a "free" treatment isn't free anymore because they have to pay for it out of their own pocket. So now, going to a doctor for a \$10,000 knee replacement becomes unconscionable for them when they can fix it with a \$2-a-day nutritional supplement.

IHealthTube: You know it's funny you mentioned that under your system you would put these doctors in jail.

Joel Wallach: Yes

IHealthTube: Maybe not to that extreme, but the opposite happens where physicians like you, or others that we've talked to, get, you know, get pushed aside or their licenses taken away or get fired...

Joel Wallach: Or get fired ...

IHealthTube: It's kind of happening in the reverse order right now still. Isn't it?

Joel Wallach: Yes. It's still happening incorrectly because, of course, the pharmaceutical industry and the medical monopoly — it's a monopoly — is in control. They give more money to PAC committees, to legislators, than any other group there is. OK? And the thing that happens is when you give that much money to legislators, suddenly now these guys are the only guys. Everybody knows that the medical system is the perfect ... the single worthy system because it's the only system.

Now this was know 290 years ago. The first U.S. Surgeon General — a guy by the name of Benjamin Rush, who was an MD — realized that the different philosophies of medicine were fighting amongst each other. They were actually having gunfights in the street. Certain groups of medical doctors would take over a household, lock the doors, and the other groups of medical doctors would march down to the town armory and get a cannon and blow the door off. Then they'd go in and have gunfights because one [group] was homeopaths, and other ones used herbs, and the other ones liked physical medicine and stuff. They were literally having gunfights over this.

And so, Benjamin Rush, who was the top surgeon for the Continental Army during the revolution ... George Washington personally appointed him as the first U.S. Surgeon General ... there is a very famous story ... he said that he wanted an amendment to the constitution which said that people would have their choices of medical sciences. He said, "if we don't have an amendment in the constitution giving people their free choice ... free choice of which medical science they want, like their choice of religion and freedom of speech ... he said somewhere along the line — and I'm quoting him now — "one class of men will take over the medical sciences and it will be the Bastille of America." His fears have become our nightmare 290 years later, because the free enterprise system has never taken place in the medical industry since the American Medical Association was formed.

Everything they have done for the last hundred years was not to learn how to treat patients better. Everything they've done for the last hundred years has been designed to kill off all competition. And make them the sole source of "medical knowledge" — "The Ones", the chosen ones — that was their goal. And they've become successful. And so the only way this is going to become undone is if people stop using this failed and corrupt system we know as our medical system.

Right now the average life span of Americans makes us 46th in the world in longevity. There are 45 other countries whose peoples live longer than us. We're 92nd in healthfulness. We spend more money for health care than all the other 218 nations in the world put together. So their system is a failed — and it's a corrupt system.

And so, again, the people are going to have to rise up here and choose to do things themselves. And then the medical system becomes unfunded. If nobody is using them, how can you justify funding them? And so this is how it's going to have to happen. Because the pharmaceutical industry and the medical industry is so powerful ... and they form that I call the "unholy trilogy" with government ... and the pharmaceutical industry and the medical system for this unholy trilogy ... and they, according to the Center For Disease Control and their own journal, the Journal Of The American Medical Association, 4 ½ years ago, it was February 7, 2007, they came out and said that — these two agencies, the Journal Of The American Medical Association and the Center For Disease Control, the federal agency that tracks these things — that medical doctors kill, injure and infect 15 million of their patients every year in American hospitals and private offices. 5.8 million in hospitals and 9.2 [million] in private offices. They kill, injure and infect 15 million. They don't even get an OSHA ticket. They get a walk.

Now, what if cab drives were to do that? Everybody would say, “my gosh, I’m going to walk.” “Well, Roy, it’s 50 miles to the airport.” “I’ll just leave three days early, but I’m walking. I ain’t getting’ in a cab.” But people still line up to get this very dangerous, very ineffective ... I mean we rank 46th in the world in longevity and 92nd in healthfulness. The recipe is not a good recipe, Scott.
